Re: Ordinance No.: 25 – Regulating Display of House Numbers

The Town Board of the Town of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wisconsin,
RESOLVES as follows:

Ordinance 25 – Regulating Display of House Numbers is hereby amended as presented to include the following changes:

Section 25.1, 25.2, 25.3, 25.4, and 25.5 shall read:

25.1 Display of House Numbers

Owners and occupants of every house, mobile home, business, and building on a vacant lot in the Town of Grand Rapids shall display house numbers according to this ordinance.

25.2 Numbering

All Buildings in the Town shall be numbered in accordance with Wood County Building numbering requirements, as designated in County Ordinance 105. All buildings shall be numbered to conform as nearly as possible to the general scheme of numbering as pursuant to the standards maintained by the Wood County Emergency Government Office.

25.3 Numbers, Size and Location

For all buildings situated less than seventy-five (75) feet from the center of the roadway, such numbers shall be conspicuously placed near the front or main entrance door of each dwelling so that the number can be plainly seen from the street. The dimension of each number installed shall not be less than 2-1/4 by 3-1/2 inches.

Whenever any building is situated more than seventy-five (75) feet from center of the roadway, the number of such building shall be installed, preferably reflectorized, and conspicuously displayed approximately 12 feet near the driveway or common entrance thereto or upon a gate, post or other appropriate place so as to be easily seen from the street.

25.4 Mailboxes

In addition, mailboxes shall have building numbers affixed by owners and occupants in sufficient size to be seen from the road.

25.5 Noncompliance and Penalties

Previously installed numbers not complying with this ordinance shall be replaced or supplemented with compliant numbers. Any person, firm or corporation failing to comply with Section 1 of this Ordinance shall forfeit the sum as per Ordinance 39 “Schedule of Fees and Forfeitures” together with the costs of prosecution. Each day of noncompliance with the terms of this Ordinance shall be a separate violation.

This ordinance amended by a majority of the town board with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, amends the attached Ordinance 25 – Regulating Display of House Numbers.
