

ORDINANCE NO: 20

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF TOWN BOARD MEMBERS TO FIVE

The Town Board of the Town of Grand Rapids, Wisconsin, pursuant to § 60.21 Wisconsin Statutes does ordain as follows with regard to its Town Ordinances:

20.1 Supervisors Elected to Five

The number of supervisors elected to serve on the Town Board shall be increased to five effective with the next election to be held pursuant to this ordinance.

20.2 Election Process

The two additional supervisors to be added pursuant to this ordinance shall be elected during an election to be held in the Spring of 1980. The newly elected supervisors shall take office during the year of their election in the same manner as the members elected during the odd-numbered years and as provided by Wisconsin Statutes.

20.3 Continuing Elections

The election of the remaining three supervisors shall continue to occur in odd-numbered years. The status of the three supervisors elected during the 1979 Spring Election shall remain unaffected by this ordinance.

20.4 Election Conduct

The Spring Election to occur in 1980 shall be conducted in accordance with the applicable Wisconsin Statutes and shall be in the same manner as the election taking place in odd-numbered years.

20.5 Terms of Office

The terms of elected town officers which shall expire after 11:59 p.m. on the 2nd Monday of April in either April 2012 or April 2013 shall be extended until the 3rd Tuesday of April in the same year in which the terms would otherwise have expired. Thereafter, terms shall expire as provided for in the Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as provided by law.
