

ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION WORKERS

The Town Board Of The Town Of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wisconsin, Pursuant To Sec. 7.30(1) Of The Wisconsin Statutes, Does Ordain As Follows:

66.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the appointment of two sets of election officials to work at different times on each Election Day.

66.2 Appointment Authorized

There shall be one set of election officials appointed pursuant to sec. 7.30 (1) (a) and (4) Wis. Stats. with election officials allowed to work either shift.

66.3 Separate Election Day Shifts

There shall be two shifts for election officials on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 1:30 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 p.m. and end with the completion of all required Election Day duties that follow closure of the polls.

66.4: Additional Inspector

Pursuant to sec. 7.30 (1) (b) Wis. Stats., the town board shall for each election appoint one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. and one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 1:30 p.m. and 8 p.m. at the polling place in the town. Each additional election inspector appointed herein shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance shall take effect from upon of its passage and publication as provided by law.
