Call 911! Stay on the telephone with the dispatcher. Wood County Communications Center will send a Grand Rapids police officer and/or a Wood County Sheriff's deputy. Give the dispatcher the following information:



1. Your name, address, and telephone number
2. Type of crime – burglary, assault, fight, suspicious vehicle or person, etc.
3. Tell the dispatcher if the crime is happening right now or if it has already occurred
4. Give the dispatcher a description of the person(s) or vehicle(s) – use this sheet to help you
5. Tell the dispatcher which direction the person(s) or vehicle(s) traveled, if they have left the area
