Closure of LAKE WAZEETCHA

In keeping with the best interests of public welfare and safety, the Town of Grand Rapids Ordinance 35 has been enacted for the following boundaries of Lake Wazeecha effective from 6:00 a.m. August 29, 2015 until 7:30 p.m. August 29, 2015.

The purpose of this lake closer is to ensure the safe conduct of the World Record Water Ski Pyramid Attempt on Lake Wazeecha during the time frame indicated above.

The area of closure affects all waters of Lake Wazeecha, from CTH "U" (80th Street South) bridge, west to the Lake Wazeecha dam from 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. From 3:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. only those waters, east of a line from the 64th Street South boat landing, extending north to the north shore of Lake Wazeecha, and all water area east to CTH U (80th Street South) bridge will remain closed. **THE WHITE SANDS DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREA WILL REMAIN OPEN TO SWIMMERS DURING THE ABOVE MENTIONED TIME FRAMES.** The aforementioned area has been placarded, advising of restrictions. Those restrictions shall be any recreational use within the waterway, including but not limited to:

- Boating**
- Swimming/Scuba Diving**
- Recreational wading**
- Fishing from a boat or shore**
- Water Skiing**
