RESOLUTION NO: 2017-23

Re: Ordinance No. 2 – Regulating Burning and Prevention/Suppression

The Town Board of the Town of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wisconsin,
RESOLVES as follows:

Ordinance 2 – Regulating Burning and Prevention/Suppression is hereby amended as presented.

The Town Board of the Town of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Chapters 60 and 66 of Wisconsin Statutes, and specifically § 60.555, Wis. Stats. to amend this ordinance.

In order to make verbiage consistent with the DNR’s guidelines, the restriction for burning on Sundays and Holidays has been removed. Section 2.4 will now read as follows:

2.4 Permits

It shall be unlawful to burn brush, rubbish or any other debris within any part of the Town of Grand Rapids without a burning permit; unless there is complete ground cover of snow that is more than one inch (1”).

The burning of brush, rubbish or any other debris in any part of the Town of Grand Rapids shall only take place in accordance with permit guidelines.

Permits for control burning in the Town of Grand Rapids can be obtained from the Municipal Building, authorized Fire Wardens for the Town of Grand Rapids, or the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Service Center.

All Town residents must adhere to all sections, rules, and regulations of this Ordinance.

This ordinance amended by a majority of the town board with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, amends the attached Ordinance 2 – Regulating Burning and Prevention/Suppression.
