

Resolution Number 2021-04

PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION FOR DISCONTINUING AN UNDEVELOPED PORTION OF ACACIA AVENUE, TOWN OF GRAND RAPIDS, WOOD COUNTY WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Grand Rapids, on the 13th day of April, 2021, by this Resolution adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

The process under Chapter 66.1003, Wis. Stats. to discontinue a public way in the Town described as follows is hereby initiated:

An undeveloped East-West portion of Acacia Avenue, from its point of intersection with Golf Course Road to a point 266.62 feet East where said road intersects Country Lane; said portion of road being 30-feet wide and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the NW Cor. of Lot 1 of CSM 9399, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING. Thence along the Easterly R/W Line of Golf Course Road on a bearing of N 00°58'00" W a distance 30.00'. Thence along the North R/W Line of Acacia Ave. on a bearing of S 89°27'01" E a distance 266.62'. Thence along the West R/W Line of Country Lane on a bearing of S 01°01'38" E a distance 30.00'. Thence S 89°27'01" W a distance 266.62' to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Being situated in Govt. Lot 3, in the Southwest Quarter of the Section 19, Township 22 North of Range 6 East, in the Town of Grand Rapids, Wood County, Wisconsin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, a Public Hearing to discuss proposed Resolution No. 2021-__ (a copy of which is included in this document, below the Notice) to discontinue a public way in the Town of Grand Rapids shall be held on the 8th day of June, 2021 at the Town of Grand Rapids, Town Hall, 2410 48th Street South, Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin, beginning at 6:00PM, provided in accordance with a Notice of Hearing as required under Ch. 985, Wis. Stat. The Town Board will at that time consider said Resolution to discontinue the above-noted portion of public way.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Clerk shall publish a Notice of Hearing as a Class III Notice under Chapter 985, Wis. Stats., and the Town Clerk shall cause the Notice of Hearing to be served on the owners of land abutting the highway to be discontinued, and any other parties required to be served under Wis. Stat. 66.1003(4)(b), in the manner provided for the service of summons in Circuit Court at least 30 days before the hearing, except that when service cannot be made within the Town, a copy of the notice shall be mailed to the owner's last-known address at least 30 days before the hearing.


A map of the land that will be affected by this application is attached to this resolution, and incorporated by reference.
